
Where is EUC 2026?

EPICS Module of the Month

Did you know that there are 14 different EPICS Modules? Each module is designed with our customers in mind and many were created based on customer feedback.

The Module of the Month for March is the Corrective Action Module. Even in the best extrusion plant, problems occur with shipped metal that must be resolved. The EPICS Corrective Action module helps you establish a positive response to these problems.

The module includes numerous features to use in a program of resolving customer complaints and eliminating future complaints:



- Generate and print a Return Material Authorization (RMA)
- Generate and print a Scrap Authorization document
- Easy entry of a replacement order for returned or scrapped material
- Method of highlighting a replacement workorder (bold heading, special fonts, etc.)
- Link to an EPICS Credit document, providing documentation for the credit
- One-click recall of Corrective Action history for any die, part, or customer

The EPICS Corrective Action Module was developed at the request of EPICS users. Numerous extrusion personnel provided input during design sessions held at EPICS User Conferences.

New SSP Benefit: Annual EPICS User Training

A new benefit has been added to the Software Service Policy (SSP). Now included with EPICS Enterprise edition (16 or more user licenses) is EPICS user training for one person from your company annually. We regularly offer a 4-day EPICS User Training class throughout the year, both online and in Farmersville. If your company has at least 16 user licenses, your company can register 1 person per year for this training class free of charge.

Class size is limited and the number of free seats in each class is limited, so we recommend registering early for the training classes. The next online training session meets May 18-21. Online and In-person EPICS and Report Writing Training

EPICS User Training is available in-person at our training facility in Farmersville, Texas as well as online. In this four-day class, trainees work through the entire EPICS interface. The next in person classes will meet March 23-26, 2026 and June 22-25, 2026. The next online class is scheduled for May 18-21 2026.

For online classes, a good internet connection and dual monitors are essential. One monitor is needed for watching the instructor's screen and another for running EPICS.

This could be individuals in their homes or offices, or it could be several people in a conference room with a single large screen with speakers to see and hear the instructor and with individual PCs for each trainee. Trainees will connect via VPN to a training database on a Foy Inc server.



This is a great opportunity to provide training for your administrators and key users. Training is valuable not only for new users, but also as a refresher for long-time EPICS users. Much has been added to EPICS V9 in the past few years, and there are probably other things that have been forgotten. Take this opportunity to see the full scope of what EPICS has to offer.

Report Writing training is also available. This is a two-day novice level class for learning Crystal Reports with emphasis on the use of the EPICS database. Please see the [Foy Inc website](#) for details.
